While the country's in the grip of a mini-heatwave, what better time to book a long weekend away and shoot off with (or without) the wife in tow? We've taken a selection of some of the newest luggage to make your life easier along the way.

Givi have two fabric bags – the TW01 holdall (£57.48) and TW02 rollbag (£46.68). Both are in heat-sealed plastic and fabric and attach with two tubular, elastic straps. The TW01 has a 40-litre capacity, padded handles and detachable shoulder strap. The TW02 is 30 litres and has a padded underside. There's also a new rucksack, the T487 (below, £83.88). In Cordura, it has waterproof zips, and an extendable main section to up carrying capacity from 24 to 32 litres. An interior pocket expands into a rain cover and a detachable, lockable helmet holder.

Oxford have launched a new range of roll-top luggage which is claimed waterproof. Everything in the range comes with a removable liner, is made from ripstop Nylon, has compression straps (to squeeze every last drop of air from the bag) and is guaranteed for life. There's a large or medium touring tailpack (£89.99 and £69.99), 30-litre (pictured below left) and 50-litre sports backpack (£59.99 and £79.99) and a four-litre sports waistpack (pictured below, £24.99).

SW Motech has introduced remote control to its topbox range. The T-RaY topboxes can be locked and unlocked remotely from up to 50 metres away. It will also lock automatically, after 20 seconds. There's also a built-in anti-tamper alarm. The boxes are said to fit most bikes and scooters, in 28-, 36- and 48-litre versions, and cost from £151.21.
